

Policy regarding 'school work days' for IBL students

Preamble

Students enrolled in the Industry Based Learning (IBL) class at LaSalle Catholic College partake in work placement, work trials or work days under their apprenticeship training, for two days a week (Thursday and Friday) beginning at the commencement of Term 2 in the Preliminary Course (Year 11). This continues in the HSC Course (Year 12) on a Tuesday and Wednesday.

Mandatory provisions

In the event that a student is unable to attend a workplace because of a number of reasons, not restricted to but including the following:

- they do not have a placement
- The employer is unable to accommodate the student
- The student is at risk

The student should attend school as per their normal school day and report to the Head of Trade Training. Suitable 'work' duties shall be undertaken within the school environment.

IBL students who are unable to attend work on the day, due to inclement weather do not have to attend school.

Basis for discretion

There may be circumstances such as sickness or leave that prevent the student from attending school.
